Why sponsor a child's education?

Child sponsorships provide the resources necessary to give the children of AAH a well-rounded education and help meet their basic health and nutrition needs. AAH parents are asked to work in partnership with their child's sponsor by either paying reduced school fees or volunteering their time at the school.

How Does the AAH Child Sponsorship Program work?

Become a Friend to a Child in Need

- To become a sponsor, fill out an application and donate \$300 annually or \$25 monthly (by credit card) to support the education of one child at AAH.
- You can indicate a preference for the approximate age and gender of the child, and AAH will honor those requests when possible.
- AAH volunteers in the U.S. receive sponsorship applications and match sponsor with child.
- AAH children have filled out their own profiles, and photographs have been taken of them all.
- You will receive a letter introducing you to your sponsored child along with his or her profile and photograph.
- Your Child Sponsor kit will also include guidelines for the program along with information and deadlines to help you communicate with your sponsored child.



- Letters from your child will be sent to you via AAH-U.S. during each of the three terms in the Ugandan school year.
- Your letters will be bundled with those from other sponsors and sent to the children each term as well.
- You have the option of sending additional letters to your child through AAH in Bumwalukani at your own expense.
- You will receive periodic updates from AAH on school events, our progress and other developments.
